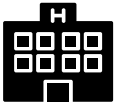

Directions from the Phoenix Sky Harbor International Airport to the

Renaissance Phoenix Downtown Hotel: Travel west on Sky Harbor Boulevard to 24th Street. Turn right-north and travel 0.9 miles to East Washington Street. Turn left-west and travel 2.4 miles to North First Street. Turn right-north and take the first left turn onto East Adams Street. The hotel will be on the right.

Rental Cars

The Rental Car Center is located within its own building at 1805 E. Sky Harbor Circle South (between 16th Street and 24th Street, south of Buckeye Road). The common Rental Car Shuttle makes frequent stops, every few minutes at the curb on baggage claim levels of each terminal. Travelers should check with their specific rental car company for hours of operation at the Airport Rental Car Center.

Taxicabs

Taxi terminal access is as follows:

Terminal 2: east outside door # 8

Terminal 3: North curb, outside door # 7

Terminal 4: Level 1, North curb, outside door # 7 and south curb, outside door #6

The following taxis are contracted to pick up passengers at Phoenix Sky Harbor:

- AAA/Yellow Cab
- Mayflower Cab
- VIP Taxi

Rates remain the same regardless of company, number of passengers and number of bags. The first mile is \$5. Each additional mile is \$2.30. Each hour of a traffic delay is \$23. The minimum fare is \$15. Effective June 18, 2016, a new \$17 flat rate is in place to downtown Phoenix within the following boundaries: North boundary: Roosevelt Street South boundary: Lincoln Street West boundary: Seventh Avenue East boundary: Seventh Street Wheelchair-accessible taxis are available upon request. All major credit cards are accepted.

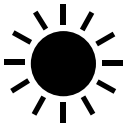

Valley Metro Rail

The PHX Sky Train® is an automated train that transports travelers between Valley Metro Rail at 44th and Washington streets, the East Economy Parking area and airport terminals. Trains arrive and depart every 3-5 minutes and operates 24 hours a day. The PHX Sky Train is free to the public and can be accessed at Terminals 3 and 4.

After disembarking the PHX Sky Train, attendees can purchase transit fare at the Valley Metro Rail 44th and Washington streets light rail platform at the fare vending machines. The all day pass is \$2. Take the rail towards downtown, 5 stops, and get off at the Washington/Central Ave. stop. The Washington/Central Ave. stop is across the street from the Renaissance Phoenix Downtown Hotel.
